

# Lake Superior Coastal Drive & Wawa Day Trip

GROUP ITINERARY



Set your alarm, grab a coffee and depart for a full day of sightseeing and history along the shores of Lake Superior/Gitchi-Gami. This spectacular drive along the largest freshwater Lake in the world in area has been named as one of the Top Ten Drives in North America. While taking in breathtaking views and experiencing endless adventure, you will be traveling along the Canadian Shield and Canada's Voyageur Route

## Depart Sault Ste. Marie to Chippewa Falls

Stop and stretch your legs at Chippewa Falls, the center of the Trans-Canada Highway, and one of the beautiful painting sites for the Group of Seven. Here you will find a "Moments of Algoma" easel where you can learn about the artist's experience in this location. From the lookout bridge, you will be able to take in a beautiful view of these majestic falls.

## Agawa Crafts and Canadian Carver

Head further north and you will discover Agawa Crafts and the Canadian Carver, located in Pancake Bay. This well known trading post is owned and operated by Serpent River First Nation. Browse through the many items of uniquely crafted indigenous art, carvings and moccasins. Don't forget to try their smoked fish.

## Lake Superior Interpretive Centre

A unique facility dedicated to the history and geography of Lake Superior. The displays in the interpretative centre highlight the power of the lake and its influence on surrounding cultures and natural landscapes.

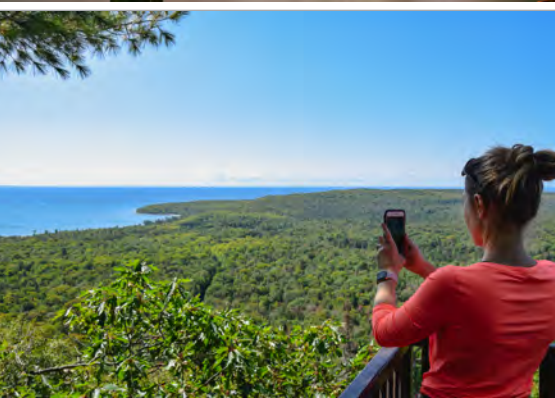

### **Agawa Bay Pictographs**

Do not miss the opportunity to visit one of Canada's famous pictograph locations, in sacred Agawa Bay. Hike the moderate trail down to the coast and see one of the most visited Indigenous archaeological sites in the country where most paintings are said to date from the 17th and 18th centuries.

### **Arrive in Wawa for Sandy Beach and Interpretive Pavilion**

Meet with a local historian, who will take you along the boardwalk to Sandy Beach where you will learn about A.Y. Jackson and his time painting as part of the Group of Seven.

### **Young's General Store and Wawa Goose**

Known for their delicious pickles, Henrietta the Moose and sweet fudge. Take a picture with one of Canada's iconic birds standing 28ft tall.

### **Depart Wawa for Old Woman's Bay Scenic Lookout**

Experience the breathtaking view of this natural wonder along Lake Superior. Take a stroll down the sandy beach, in the distance you will see the cliff-side that resembles the side profile of an old woman.

### **The River Rock Gifts Deli & Bakery in the Voyageur Lodge**

A dedicated establishment to Métis culture and heritage, purchase a souvenir and enjoy their world famous fritters. Located in the beautiful Batchewana Bay. Dip your toes in the water one last time.

### **Head back to Sault Ste. Marie**

Grab dinner at a delicious local eatery, and head back to your hotel to relax and reflect on the amazing memories you just made.
